**Report on Guest Talk by Mrs Archana Shinde, Cluster Head BYST followed with the Meeting on 8<sup>th</sup> August, 2015.**

To ensure effective implementation of the programmes of the ED cell, an advisory board is constituted in the institute which comprises of Experts from the field of entrepreneurship to guide, counsel and train the MBA to become entrepreneurs. Bhartiya Yuva Shakti Trust is one of the Advisory Board members of the ED cell. With this in mind, a meeting was organized on 08/08/2015 with the senior member of Bhartiya Yuva Shakti Trust, Mrs. Archana Shinde, Cluster head, BYST and Mr. J G Patil, Dean -2<sup>nd</sup> shift, DYPIMS in the board room of the institute with an objective of the initiating the Student Mentoring Programme for the year 2015 which was followed by the Guest talk for the IInd Year MBA students .

On behalf of Bhartiya Yuva Shakti Trust, Mrs Archana Shinde, cluster head, BYST, and Dr J G Patil, Director, DYPIMS discussed the modalities of starting the student Mentoring programme for the 30 potential entrepreneurs (SYMBA) of the institute for the year 2015.

The Meeting began with a brief introduction of the student mentoring programme by the undersigned. After the brief introduction, Mrs. Archana Shinde mentioned that “Bharatiya Yuva Shakti Trust (BYST) has always believed in assisting the students in entrepreneurship through their flagship Mentoring programme.

The key points of the meeting:

She suggested that the students of DYPIMS will be undergoing mentoring in phases as follows:

- **Phase I:** Each DYPIMS student will be allotted 5 BYST Entrepreneur, who will act as a mentor entrepreneur to the student where they will get an opportunity to meet, observe, guide, and share their experiences with the student community. This programme will help the students to get practical live experiences which will be treated as case studies in the field of entrepreneurship.
- **Phase II:** The students will further be attached to BYST’s MAP – Mentor Assigning Panel, to get trained in mentoring process. The students will also be counseled by the members of the BYST team on entrepreneurship on a regular basis.

Dr J G Patil expressed his gratitude to Mrs Archana Shinde, Cluster head, BYST for selecting the students of DYPIMS for their flagship Mentoring Programme, he also mentioned that such joint efforts will help develop the students in the field of entrepreneurship.

This initiative was taken by the ED cell to ensure that esteemed organizations like Bhartiya Yuva Shakti Trust continue to guide, counsel and mentor our potential entrepreneurs (2nd Year MBA students).

This meeting was followed with the talk organized for the entire 2<sup>nd</sup> Year MBA students on the topic of “BYST & its Role in developing Entrepreneurs through Mentoring Process”. The programme began with the felicitation of the guest speaker by the Dr J G Patil, Dean-2<sup>nd</sup> shift, DYPIMS.

Mrs Archana Shinde explained the various aspects of entrepreneurship as a career option and the subsequent role played by BYST in developing the same amongst the student fraternity. She also believed that Entrepreneurship Development Cell of the institute will not only develop the students but in turn will contribute to the development of the entire nation. The students were highly motivated to hear that they will be mentored by the corporates and the first session of mentoring would be held immediately after the guest talk. The total number of 2<sup>nd</sup> year students who attended the guest lecture was 78.

The guest talk concluded by the vote of thanks by the undersigned, Prof. Shilpa R Kankonkar, Chairman ED Cell, DYPIMS. The selected 30 potential entrepreneurs students were then asked to gather in the ED cell of the institute for the one to one mentoring session with the guest speaker.
