### **“FINANCE FOR NON FINANCE EXECUTIVES”**

Executive education has always been an important constituent at the portfolio of offerings at Padmashree Dr. D. Y. Patil Institute of Management Studies (DYPIMS). It was organized on 10<sup>th</sup> January, 2015 & the title was “Finance for the non- Finance Executives”. Three eminent experts from the Industry & Academia were invited upon to train on the following-

22 participants from the Industry and Academia participated in this one day programme.

The session was initiated with the welcome address by the Director, Dr. Rajesh Arora followed by the inaugural speech by the M.D. Operations, Mr. Bharat Chavan Patil.

Prof. Vinany Nandre & Prof. Sibi Abraham were the coordinators for this Management Development Programme. The compere for the MDP was done Prof. Minal Waghchoure.



The first session was addressed by Mr. Kiran Jadhav, a partner in precision investment services.

He spoke about how the Industry of Mutual funds grew over a period of time citing the rising interest to invest amongst the Indians. Giving the classic examples of the scams from the past in the share market, he spoke on how SEBI today has been able to control & regulate the markets effectively through its policy guidelines. A very beautiful, self explanatory video was also showcased. He also said that it is important to invest to beat inflation & how one can increase the returns to make their future safe & better. Further, he shared his immense knowledge and expertise on the share market Industry, Investment planning, various lucrative sources of investments. In his three hour session, he covered all the aspects of Personal Finance.



The second eminent speaker, post the lunch was Dr. V. S. Kaveri, Partner, Precision Investment Services.

He touched upon various trends & issues existing in the banking sector. We all had profited from the wealth of his learning & experience. He started with an overview of the banking sector & the market situation in the 70s. He spoke at length, on 'Demystifying Banking procedures'. He gave certain classic examples from the Banking field, shared the competitive scenario existing in the market today. He emphasized on various aspects like Mass retirement & mass recruitment, technology having the shades of both sides of the coin. He stressed on the point that today the sector needs an urgent attention towards increasing the number of the banks in order to survive. For students & academia, he also suggested "Consolidation" as a topic of research. His words were informative which helped us upgrade vividly on the Banking sector.



Mr. Amitabh Chatteraj, the third expert on the theme, gave an energetic address explaining the concept of "Budgeting & forecasting". He also threw light upon the functioning & the relevance of the Working capital management. During his address, he gave various live examples of companies like Infosys, etc. He spoke on the Singhur case as well. Further adding, he stressed upon; how India has an edge over other Asian countries like China on the factors such as Age, English, Capital, etc.

The address by all the three experts was illuminative & informative. The live examples, cases, facts cited by all the three eminent speakers made the one day programme very educative & interesting.



Post the sessions, all the participants came forward to share their feedback on the programme.

Overall, it was a great success and another feather in the cap of DYPIMS. This program helped every participant carry some valuable & resourceful learning with them.
