



## Report on Research & Development Day 2014

DYPIMS reserves October 31 as the Research & Development (R&D) Day. A Student Research Paper Presentation Competition was held on the occasion of R & D day in 2014. All the research papers written by students & screened by their guides/mentors were presented on this day.

The event was conducted in the seminar hall (001).

The panel of judges included

The event started with felicitation of the panel of judges followed by an inaugural address by the Director.

11 papers were presented by students and they were assessed by the panel of judges based on the parameters (marks) such as Introduction (10), Research Methodology (15), Data Analysis and Interpretation (15) Findings (15), Suggestions (15) and Presentation Skills (30). The panel of Judges asked questions post the presentation of each student and suggested improvements in the research papers.

At the end of the student's presentation, the panel members appreciated the efforts of the institute in organizing this competition. The winners based on the average marks given by the judges were declared & they were as follows

The prize included a certificate and a cash prize as follows
